### 1-1-0 ACTION ITEMS

1-1-1 Recycling Program: Metro emphasized it would be prudent for HCCO to be very sensitive about recycling materials on the project. Metro tabled a preliminary estimate (attachments, Fig. #1 and #2) concerning recycling for HCCO's review. HCCO requested Metro not start removal of any potential materials for recycling until HCCO has defined the design further and how materials will be reused with the design. HCCO will review the project recycling needs and produce a program for recycling.

1-1-2 <u>Prevailing Wages/Recycling:</u> HCCO questioned how the project prevailing wage rule would be enforced as it relates to recycling and salvaging of materials. Metro will review the issue and get with HCCO.

1 - 1 - 3Hazardous Waste: Metro explained there are several areas of materials on the project which will need to be hazardous The main areas are as follow: a) Roof insulation; b) addressed. VAT flooring; c) light ballasts; and d) miscellaneous asbestos at The oil storage tank is being removed by PDI piping, etc. Metro requested HCCO do an estimate on removal of the presently. insulation based on a normal non-hazardous VAT and roof demolition. HCCO will put the estimates together but requested a copy of the asbestos survey. Metro will get HCCO a copy.

1-1-4 <u>Marblecrete Test Results:</u> HCCO questioned whether the exterior marblecrete panels contain any asbestos. Metro explained a detailed testing by PDI indicated the panels were not a material requiring hazardous demolition methods. Metro will get HCCO a copy of the PDI test results.

1-1-5 Jobsite Offices: HCCO explained they will be setting up their construction offices in the basement level of the building and questioned Metro on what they would need for their offices. Metro explained they will definitely need a separate office but could be flexible on the conference room requirements. All parties agreed HCCO should submit a proposed plan of the offices so Metro can review.

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<u>Minority Participation:</u> Metro voiced concern about HCCO being proactive in creating minority participation on the project. HCCO acknowledged the importance of being active with minority participation and will proceed accordingly. HCCO will report back on the minority participation issue.

Best Locks: Metro explained they desired Best locks on the project even though the RFP did not call for them. HCCO will look at the RFP requirements and write the hardware bid proposal such that competition can still be present.

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<u>Ramp Location:</u> Metro explained they would like to see the parking ramp shifted to the east one bay so they create a large area for possible expansion. HCCO will review shifting the ramp against the traffic flow plan and get back with Metro.

- 1-4-1 <u>Telephone Service vs. Vault:</u> Metro requested HCCO continue to provide telephone service from Irving Street in lieu of utilizing the existing GTE vault.
- 1-4-2 <u>Elevator and Window Design</u>: HCCO reported they are pursuing pricing proposals on the elevator and window systems at this time.
- 1-4-3 <u>Sprinkler/Water Piping:</u> HCCO explained that presently the building waterlines and sprinkler piping are charged. The concern by HCCO is the potential freezing weather causing a break on the piping versus the risk of leaving the water on.
- 1-4-4 Project Meetings: All parties agreed the next project meeting will occur on 1/2/92 at 2:00 p.m. at the TVA office. Future project meetings will occur on Thursdays at 2:00 p.m.
- 1-4-5 <u>Blazer Shuttle:</u> Metro reported the Blazer group is scheduled to start utilizing the old parking lot in February, March, or April 1992 for shuttle service. Metro explained that street traffic will need to be kept clear during that time.

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1-4-6 Project Fence: Metro explained they do not feel a perimeter site fence will be necessary until the exterior wall demolition begins.
