Parking

Directions

Access to the Locks is from Hwy 43/
Willamette Drive, at the west end of the
Oregon City Arch Bridge. The Willamette
Falls Locks is adjacent to the West Linn
Paper Company, which operates seven
days a week. Park in the West Linn Paper
Company Shuttle Truck Parking Lot on the
east side of Mill Street. Enter the lot by the
intersection of Territorial and Mill Street.
Walk south from there to the Security
office. Security will direct you to the work
area. Volunteer parking is not available in
the lower parking lot
