Re: Split Letter for FFY2024 Apportionment funding

Dear Ms. Fletcher:

This letter confirms the agreement between TriMet, SMART, and C-TRAN on distributing the Federal FFY2024 full-year apportionment Formula funding, ending September 30, 2024, available to the Portland, OR-WA Urbanized Area.

Formula funds include Section 5307 – Urbanized Area Funds (and Section 5340 – Growing States), Section 5337 – High-Intensity Motorbus (HIMB), Section 5337 – High-Intensity Fixed Guideway (HIFG), State of Good Repair Funds, Section 5339 – Bus and Bus Facilities Funds and Section 5310 – Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Funds. The distribution of the funds is shown in the table as follows:
