Summary of Amendment Changes Occurring:

The admin mod expands the project limits by including approved locations on OR99E from to MP 1.10 to MP 5.49. This adds 1,84 miles to the project limits on OR99E. No change in scope is occurring. No change in funding is occurring. The limits change reflect a technical mapping correction for the limits. The added portion on OR99E was missed during the original project programming submission. Note: The PE phase was completed under Key 22978.

Why Changes May Proceed Administratively:

The project limits do not change scope, but correct the missing limits section not identified during the original MTIP and STIP programming, The ADA upgrades are exempt and the limit changes have no impact on the transportation model or air conformity. As such, the limit changes are considered a minor scope change and can occur administratively.



GARVEE Bonds	GARVEE bonds, or Grant Anticipation Revenue Vehicles, are a type of tax-exempt debt instrument used to finance transportation projects. They are repaid using future federal highway funds, rather than state tax revenues, and allow states to accelerate project construction timelines.



General	Any project changes that do not meet the MTIP amendment criteria in the Full Amendments section. To qualify as an administrative modification, the project change(s) must clearly fit into the below categories without exceeding the category threshold. Some exceptions may be possible. These will be treated on an individual case-by-case basis to determine and verify that: - Fiscal constraint is not impacted by the change - Air quality in not impacted as a result of the change - A capacity changes is not occurring which would impact the Metro Motor Vehicle transportation modeling network. - The project change does not involve canceling the project or construction phase from he MTIP.								

Completing Technical Corrections	Completing Minor technical corrections to make the printed STIP consistent with prior approvals, such as typos or missing data.
Scope Changes that do not Impact	Completing Minor Scope Changes: Project adjustments that result from minor scope changes can occur as an administrative modification under the following conditions: -The changes to the project costs remain under the formal amendment cost thresholdThe changes to the project limits and location remain under the formal amendment thresholdThe changes are non-capacity, air quality exempt changes which include examples listed in 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2 and 40 CFR 93.127, Table 3 -The changes result in the project still being consistent with the RTP through fiscal constraint, performance assessment, goals, and strategies verificationsFor Metro RFFA funded projects, the project is still consistent with the original RFFA award in scope, location, and limits
