THE METRO COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a new Section 2.01.210 is added to the Code to read as follows:

"2.01.210 Temporary Staff Assignment to Assist Council

Upon adoption of a resolution specifying the position(s) to be transferred, the Executive Officer shall temporarily assign to the Presiding Officer such staff as shall be necessary for the Council to prepare ordinances or studies being considered for Council approval. Such temporary assignments shall be for a period specified in the resolution not to exceed ninety (90) days.

The resolution shall state the specific need of the Council for temporary assistance, the ordinance or study the Council is considering, and the duration of the assignment."

2. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare of the Metro area in order to meet obligations and comply with Oregon Budget Law, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect upon passage.
