1. That a new Section 2.01.210 is	added to the Code to read as follows:

Upon adoption of a resolution specifyi	ng the position(s) to be transferred, the Executive
Officer shall temporarily assign to the Presiding	ng Officer such staff as shall be necessary for the
Council to prepare ordinances or studies being	considered for Council approval. Such temporary
assignments shall be for a period specified in t	the resolution not to exceed ninety (90) days.
The resolution shall state the specific r	need of the Council for temporary assistance, the
ordinance or study the Council is considering,	and the duration of the assignment."
2. This Ordinance being necessar	y for the immediate preservation of the public
health, safety or welfare of the Metro area in o	order to meet obligations and comply with Oregon
Budget Law, an emergency is declared to exis	t, and this Ordinance takes effect upon passage.
