for the purpose of transferring \$______ of General Fund (Excise Tax) resources from the Planning Fund Personal Services to the Support Services Fund Office of General Counsel Materials and Services to contract for additional professional services in order to prepare findings needed for the adoption of Ordinance 96-655B relating to the urban reserve selection process.

2. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare of the Metro area in order to meet obligations and comply with Oregon Budget Law, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect upon passage.
