FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

ORDINANCE NO. 91-398A, AMENDING THE FY 90-91 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION SCHEDULE TO FUND DUE DILIGENCE COSTS RELATED TO THE METRO HEADQUARTERS RELOCATION PROJECT

Date: June 10, 1991 Presented by: Councilor Hansen

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: At its June 6, 1991 meeting the Committee voted unanimously to recommend Council adoption of Ordinance No. 91-398 as amended. All Committee members were present and voting.

COMMITTEE DISCUSSION / ISSUES: Jennifer Sims, Director of Finance and Management Information presented the staff report. She pointed out the ordinance requests transfer of \$20,000 from the Building Fund Contingency and \$80,000 from the Capital Outlay to the Miscellaneous Professional Services line item in the Building Fund Materials and Services category. The purpose of the transfer is to properly budget and account for expenditures already incurred on due diligence costs for the Sears facility project.

Ms. Sims introduced a proposed amendment which would authorize an additional \$10,000 of expenses for the Sears project (see Attachment 1 to this Committee Report). Ms. Sims indicated recent discussions between Metro staff and potential developer have rekindled interest in pursuing the Sears project. Ms. Sims indicated that additional fund would not be spent towards this project until the Council agrees to proceed further. She indicated a meeting of the Relocation Task Force has been set for Friday, June 7, 1991 to review this matter.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

On October 11, 1990, the Council agreed to proceed with the purchase of the Sears facility as Metro's new office headquarters. The agency entered into a due diligence period which extended through April 30, 1991. During the due diligence period accurate cost and revenue data were compiled and means for reducing the potential risks were evaluated. During this period, several outside consultants were utilized to develop financial, engineering, construction and leasing alternative reports. The recommendation of the Relocation Task Force was to not pursue the purchase of the Sears Facility under the existing purchase agreement.

Costs associated with the due diligence period were to be either funded through the financing secured for the purchase of the facility or by the existing Building Management Fund if outside financing was not secured. The total project costs are identified in Attachment A to this staff report. These costs will be funded through a combination of savings in existing appropriation and a transfer from Contingency.

This action requests the transfer of \$20,000 from the Building Management Fund Contingency and \$80,000 from Capital Outlay to the Miscellaneous Professional Services line item in Materials & Services.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Officer recommends adoption of Ordinance 91-398, transferring \$20,000 from the Building Management Fund Contingency and \$80,000 from Capital Outlay to fund due diligence costs related to the Metro Headquarters relocation project.
