Description	TriMet along with 11 other partnering & awarded agencies received a FTA Section 5312 discretionary grant in October 2016 supporting the Mobility on Demand (MOD) Sandbox Program. The MOD Sandbox Program is part of a larger research effort at DOT that supports transit agencies and communities as they integrate new mobility tools like smart phone apps, bike- and car-sharing, and demand-responsive bus and van services. TriMet's project will create a platform integrating transit and shared-use mobility options. TriMet will build on its existing trip planning app to incorporate shared use mobility options and more sophisticated functionality and interfaces, including data sharing for shared-use mobility providers. By integrating data, the project will allow users to plan trips that address first/last mile issues while traveling by transit.
